### 3. <u>THE ACT</u> (Section 51(1) (b))

### 6. FORM OF REQUEST (Section 51 (1) (e))

To facilitate the processing of your request, kindly:

- **6.1** Use the prescribed form, available on the website of the SOUTH AFRICAN HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION at www.sahrc.org.za.
- **6.2** Address your request to the Head of the Company (CEO).
- **6.3** Provide sufficient details to enable the COMPANY to identify:
  - (a) The record(s) requested;
  - (b) The requester (and if an agent is lodging the request, proof of capacity);
  - (c) The form of access required;
  - (d) (i) The postal address or fax number of the requester in the Republic;
    - (ii) If the requester wishes to be informed of the decision in any manner (in addition to written) the manner and particulars thereof;
  - (e) The right which the requester is seeking to exercise or protect with an explanation of the reason the record is required to exercise or protect the right.

# 7. PRESCRIBED FEES (Section 51 (1) (f))

The following applies to requests (other than personal requests):

- **7.1** A requestor is required to pay the prescribed fees (R50.00) before a request will be processed;
- **7.2** If the preparation of the record requested requires more than the prescribed hours (six), a deposit shall be paid (of not more than one third of the access fee which would be payable if the request were granted);
- **7.3** A requestor may lodge an application with a court against the tender/payment of the request fee and/or deposit;
- **7.4** Records may be withheld until the fees have been paid.
- **7.5** The fee structure is available on the website of the SOUTH AFRICAN HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION at <a href="https://www.sahrc.org.za">www.sahrc.org.za</a>.

#### 9. DENIAL OF ACCESS

Access to any record may be refused under certain limited circumstances. These include:

 The protection of personal information from unreasonable disclosure concerning any

natural person;

- The protection of commercial information held concerning any third party;
- The protection of financial, commercial, scientific or technical information that may

the commercial or financial interest of any third party;

- Disclosure that would result in a breach of duty of confidence owed to a third party;
- Disclosure that would result in a breach of a duty of confidence owed to third party;
- Disclosure that would prejudice or impair the security of property or means of transport;
- Disclosure that would prejudice or impair the protection or means of transport;
- Disclosure that are privileged from production in legal proceedings unless the privilege

has been waived:

- Disclosure of details of any computer programme;
- Disclosure that will put Digital Interactive (Pty) Ltd at a disadvantage in contractual or

other negotiations or prejudice it in commercial competition;

• Disclosures of any record containing any trade secrets, financial, commercial, scientific, or

technical information that would harm the commercial or financial interest of ESK Security

Services (Pty) Ltd;

• Disclosures of any record containing information about research and development being

carried out or about to be carried out by Digital Interactive (Pty) Ltd

If access to a record or any relevant information is denied, our response will include:

- · Adequate reasons for the refusal; and
- Notice that you may lodge an application with the court against the refusal and the procedure including details of the period for lodging the application.
